With 104 beds across the reserve, your closest friends and family can settle in, switch off, and celebrate with you from the first sundowner to the final embrace.

This booklet has been put together as your companion through the planning months ahead. Inside, you'll find everything you need to know about our spaces, our food, our accommodation, the small rules that protect this wild place, and the gentle rhythm of a wedding weekend here, so that you can spend less time worrying about details and more time enjoying the build-up.

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CHAPTER I

Our place *in the bushveld.*

Two and a half hours from Gauteng. Three thousand five hundred hectares of Waterberg wilderness. One hundred and four beds. An entire weekend that belongs only to you and the people you love.

A celebration *beyond* a single day.

Here, a wedding isn't a day, it's a weekend that begins the moment your guests turn off the car and onto our final stretch of gravel road. With the whole reserve to yourselves, your people settle in, switch off, and celebrate from start to finish, surrounded by birdsong, kudu in the long grass, and the slow change of light over the Summergeti plain.

Exchange your vows beneath the trees in our open-air chapel, wooden doors, shaded seating, and birdsong in the background. Step into sundowners on the lawn while the sun sets over the bush. Move into the warm glow of the restaurant, the Glass Barn, or under canvas on the lawn for a reception that flows seamlessly into the night.

The venue comfortably hosts fifty to one hundred guests indoors, and up to one hundred and ten under a stretch tent on the lawn. Multiple outdoor areas, a generous stoep and curated lighting mean the transition from ceremony to reception to dance floor is relaxed, stylish, and yours.

The *Summergeti* Deck.

Three places to say your vows, each with its own mood. Begin with the Deck: shaded, open-air, and deeply connected to the landscape, where vows are exchanged beneath an open sky.



THE FEELING

Dappled shade overhead, the grasses of the Summergeti plain rolling away behind you. Birdsong stands in for an organ; the wind moves through the marula trees. It is the kind of place where unforgettable moments seem to happen on their own.

GOOD TO KNOW

- Seating is shaded but the deck itself is uncovered.
- Not suitable in adverse weather, we'll arrange a backup.
- Recommended ceremony start: 15:30–16:30 in summer, 15:00–15:30 in winter.
- Aisle décor, arch and signage are bring-your-own.

A THIRD SPOT, THE OPEN FIELD

For couples who want nothing between them and the bush, we'll set your ceremony out in an *open field*, grass underfoot and the Waterberg stretching to the horizon on every side. No deck, no walls, just sky, savanna and the people you love gathered in a clearing. The most untamed of the three, and unforgettable in good weather; like the Deck, the Glass Barn stands by as a weather backup.



The *Glass* Barn.

Our weather-protected ceremony space, and a beautiful choice in its own right.

If the bushveld decides to roll in a storm, or if you simply prefer a sheltered ceremony, the Glass Barn is your home. Cathedral-pitched, glass-fronted, opening out onto the reserve, it carries the same wild views without the wind.

THREE SPACES, SIDE BY SIDE

- **Summergeti Deck**, open-air, romantic, weather-permitting.
- **Open Field**, untamed bushveld clearing, weather-permitting.
- **Glass Barn**, sheltered, year-round, glass-fronted.
- The Barn doubles as a backup for the Deck and the Field, decided the day before by our team with you.

CEREMONY "MUST-HAVES" WORTH KNOWING

Aisle & arch

We have an arch available on property.

Musicians & sound

Live or recorded, arrange with your DJ or live act.

Confetti

Biodegradable petals only, for our wildlife.

Four spaces, *one evening.*

Sundowners drift into canapés. Canapés drift into a long dinner. Dinner drifts into dancing under the stars. Choose where each chapter lands.



The Restaurant

UP TO 70 INSIDE · FAMILY-STYLE
OR BUFFET

The warm heart of the venue. Hanging fairy lights. Best for intimate family-style spreads where guests stay close.



The Glass Barn

LARGER GROUPS · BUFFET ONLY

For weddings over seventy, or when you want a single airy space holding ceremony, dinner and dance floor.



The Stoep

INDOOR-OUTDOOR · CANDLELIT

A veranda for long candlelit tables, the in-between of inside and out. Pairs beautifully with the restaurant. Family-style or buffet service.



The Lawn & Stretch Tent

UP TO 110 · UNDER CANVAS

Stretch tent on the lawn beside the pool, the scenic option for larger receptions.

The flow of *an evening*.

- ◇ *i.* **VOWS**
An open-air ceremony on the Summergeti Deck (or in the Barn, weather depending). Around forty minutes, including signing.
- ◇ *ii.* **SUNDOWNERS & CANAPÉS**
The newlyweds disappear with the photographer onto the reserve. Guests gather on the lawn or pool deck for drinks, lawn games and a slow descent of the sun.
- ◇ *iii.* **THE PHOTO DRIVE**
You and the photographer ride out in a game vehicle to the reserve's most iconic lookouts. Up to nine passengers; expect about an hour.
- ◇ *iv.* **SEATED FOR DINNER**
Guests are called to the table. Speeches between courses; first dance at the natural pause.
- ◇ *v.* **THE DANCE FLOOR**
Indoors or out on the stoep under fairy lights, wherever the night wants to go.



Lights low, music up, evening soft.

A weekend, *not just a day.*

THE REQUIREMENTS, NON-NEGOTIABLE

Minimum 80 Guests

A minimum of 80 guests' worth of accommodation must be booked, even where your actual guest count is lower.

Minimum Stay

Weekend weddings require a minimum 2-night stay; long-weekend weddings, a minimum 3-night stay.

For everything below, photos and descriptions live on our website, feel free to send the link to your guests when invitations go out.

Held within *the day.*

All of the below is part of your wedding booking, no add-on conversation needed.

BEFORE THE WEDDING

- Access to a florist working station with a plastic table, dustbin and broom.
- Mock table setting at least three months before your wedding, by appointment.
- Final coordinator meeting at least one month before the day.
- Basic set-up and cleaning of the facilities.
- Reception venue available for décor set-up from 08:00 on the wedding day, or from 08:00 the day before, with exclusive use.
- Use of the Summergeti Deck, the lawn and pool deck for canapés.

AFTER THE WEDDING

- Final invoice and breakage-deposit refund within two weeks.
- A discount on your stay for your first anniversary, please book well in advance.

ON THE DAY

- Basic set-up and cleaning of all facilities.
- Professional in-house bar team and bar service.
- Lawn & pool deck dressed with wooden tables, chairs, umbrellas, cocktail tables and lawn games.
- Cake table, cake knife and lifter (if you're cutting cake outdoors).
- A game-drive vehicle for the photo & video shoot, up to nine passengers, with our most iconic lookouts.
- Standard lighting in the restaurant, fairy lights and dimmable hanging bulbs.
- Silver or gold cutlery, white crockery, Champagne and wine glasses.
- Reception tables and chairs for up to 110 guests.
- Napkins in white, beige, ivory and green.
- Wine, gift and DJ tables.
- Barmen and waiters.
- Backup generator in the event of a power failure.
- Your coordinator, Jerry-Lee, on hand from your arrival through to the very end, start to finish.

What you'll *bring* to the table.

Every couple should have the freedom to make their wedding their own. These elements sit outside the venue itself, yours to shape with the suppliers you love.

ACCOMMODATION

Booked separately from the wedding. The Summergeti tents are compulsory, and a minimum of 80 guests' worth of accommodation applies. Weekend weddings carry a two-night minimum; long weekends, a three-night minimum. Up to 104 beds across our Premium Lodges, Bush Villas, Luxury Hideout Tents and Summergeti Tents.

FLORALS & DÉCOR

Arrangements, candles, installations and personalised styling are not included, couples bring their own florist and styling team to bring their vision to life.

EXTERNAL SERVICES

Photographer, videographer, marriage officer, DJ, musicians, live entertainment, stationery and printing suppliers are yours to choose. See our recommended list on page 20.

BAR & BEVERAGES

Charged separately. We offer a fully stocked bar with curated wines, spirits and cocktails, and provide bar packages or a cash bar. Outside alcohol is not permitted in the venues.

DANCE FLOOR

Available for hire and set up indoors or on the stoep, wherever the night is heading.

WEDDING CAKE

We don't do wedding cakes, but we do have some fantastic suppliers you can work with.

CHAPTER VII

At the *table.*

Each meal is a celebration of nature and art, crafted by our kitchen team, fresh, seasonal, and deeply connected to this place.

FAMILY-STYLE · BUFFET · HARVEST TABLE

Three ways to *dine*.

Choose the dining style that fits the spirit of your evening. Each venue carries its own service options, set out below. Final menu and dishes are confirmed with our chef during planning.

FAMILY-STYLE

Shared platters, table-by-table.

Relaxed and social. *Includes:* two proteins, two starches, your choice of one vegetable + one salad *or* two vegetables, plus one dessert (or three minis).

Served in the Restaurant or the Stoep.

BUFFET

Generous and varied.

Perfect for larger weddings. *Includes:* two proteins, two starches, one vegetable, one salad, plus one dessert (or three minis).

Served in the Restaurant, the Stoep, or the Glass Barn.

HARVEST TABLE

A styled grazing centrepiece.

Cured meats, cheeses, dips, fresh produce and breads, a beautiful centrepiece for canapé hour or relaxed weddings. Canapés can be added on request.

Ideal for arrival-evening gatherings.

SERVICE BY VENUE

The Glass Barn, buffet only, with the choice of a cold starter and/or a dessert table.

The Restaurant, family-style or buffet, with the choice of a dessert table or plated dessert.

Vegan, vegetarian and dairy-free preferences are accommodated at no extra charge. Halaal and Kosher catering, regrettably, we are unable to offer.

THE WEDDING TASTING MENU

Served individually, with one tasting portion shared between two guests. Canapés and late-night snacks are not included. Tasting includes **Starters 3** · **Main Proteins 3** · **Starches 3** · **Vegetables 2** · **Salads 1**, with vegetarian mains on request.

Menus are seasonal and subject to availability, your final selection is confirmed at your food tasting.

Wine, *well-poured*.

We run a fully-stocked bar from a curated cellar, proper South African wines, craft and commercial beers, ciders and spirits.

BAR SETUPS

- **Open Bar**, fully hosted for the night; choose the full range or a limited selection (beer, wine, cider only).

- **Tab Bar**, hosted up to a cap; once reached, switch to cash, close the bar, or move to a limited menu.

- **Cash Bar**, guests order and pay as they go.

- **Signature Drinks**, a hosted shortlist (a gin & tonic, a cocktail, a beer) during canapés, then any of the above.

- **Feature Station**, choose a *Gin Bar* or, as an alternative, a *Wine Station*, a dedicated tasting feature set up for canapé hour.

THE CELLAR (BRIEFLY)

Our wine list spans Stellenbosch, Franschhoek, Wellington, Paarl, Robertson and the Cape, Cabernet, Merlot, Pinotage, Shiraz, Pinot Noir, Chenin, Sauvignon, Chardonnay and a small selection of MCC. Full list available on request.

A WEDDING-ONLY POUR

An *Aperol Spritz* is offered for weddings only, a bright little aperitif that doesn't appear on our main menu. Ask your coordinator to add it to canapé hour.

THE TWO RULES

Table Wine Allowance

Couples may bring **one bottle of red and one bottle of white per ten guests** for the reception tables, free of corkage. Anything beyond that is purchased through our bar.

No Outside Drinks in Venue

No outside alcohol may be brought into the Glass Barn or Restaurant. Outside drinks *are* welcome at the houses and viewpoints, perfect for getting-ready mornings and arrival-evening braais.

Final bar selections are confirmed two weeks before your wedding.

To shape *your weekend.*

Small additions, all optional, that turn a wedding day into a long, gentle weekend. Speak to your coordinator for current pricing.

THE NIGHT BEFORE

- **Pre-Wedding Braai**, under the stars with your closest people.

ON THE RESERVE

- **Game Drives**, guided drives through the reserve.
- **Guided Walks**, into the Waterberg, on foot.
- **Specialized Levo E-Bikes**, half-day rentals.
- **Tennis Court**, complimentary use.

ON THE WEDDING DAY

- **Grooms Platter**
- **Bride's Platter**
- **Late-Night Munchies**

THE MORNING AFTER

- **Cooked Breakfast**, a buffet breakfast pre-arranged from 09:00 to 11:00, the perfect long goodbye.

*“Pick one or two, or pick them all.
Either way, the weekend lengthens.”*

The night *before*.

Most couples gather their people the evening before, an easy, unhurried meal to land everyone on the reserve before the big day. Two ways to do it; detailed menus are shaped with you closer to the time.



A Braai at Summerhill

Up at Summerhill, around the fire and under a wide Waterberg sky. Coals, good meat and long tables, the most relaxed possible start to the weekend, with everyone arriving as they please.



Dinner in the Restaurant

A sit-down dinner in the warm heart of the venue, served *buffet only*. An easy, sociable evening indoors when you'd rather not be at the mercy of the weather.

Speak to your coordinator to set the night before in motion, full menus follow at your tasting.

The few rules *we live by.*

Most of these protect the wildness around us. A few are simply practical.

All of them help us host you well.

SETUP & TIMING

- Supplier access for setup begins at 08:00; everything must be ready by 14:30.
- Breakdown and supplier collection happen the following morning, from 08:00 to 11:00.
- Recommended ceremony start, *summer* 15:30–16:30; *winter* 14:30–15:30.

DÉCOR & FLORALS

- Bring your own florals, candles and styling.
- Only biodegradable confetti or petals, for our wildlife.
- No nails, screws or adhesives on any venue structures.

TRANSPORT & ACCESS

- Guests arrange their own transport.
- The final approach is on gravel, fine for any vehicle, taken slowly.
- Google Maps directions provided on page 23.

GROUP BREAKFASTS

- If your wedding party is sitting down to breakfast together, we serve our *deluxe breakfast buffet*, not the à la carte menu.
- This keeps your guests out of an hour-long wait, our kitchen is small, and eighty separate orders at once is more than it can turn around quickly.

CLOSING TIMES

- The venue closes at 23:00 (last rounds at 22:30).
- Drinks may continue around the boma fire or on the stoep.
- Anyone not staying on the reserve off the property by *midnight*.
- After 23:00, an hourly extension fee applies, payable in advance per hour. No loud music after midnight under any circumstances.

NOISE & MUSIC

- Summerplace is a private game reserve, music is coordinated with our ground team.
- Loud music outside of your reception window is not permitted.

PETS, FIRE & WILDLIFE

- Well-behaved dogs are welcome, on a leash at all times.
- No fireworks, sky lanterns or pyrotechnics, for the safety of our guests and the wildlife.
- Mountain biking and walking trails near the venue are closed to the public on your wedding day, for privacy.

THE RESTAURANT ON YOUR DAY

- Closes to the public from 10:00 the morning of your wedding, giving us time to clean after breakfast and begin setup.
- Open as usual for your weekend stay otherwise.

WHAT WE SUPPLY, & WHAT WE DON'T

Supplied by Summerplace, tables, chairs, tablecloths, cutlery and crockery.

Not supplied, flowers, cake and outdoor furniture, these come through your own suppliers above.

The client or service provider is responsible for wrapping and packing up any additional hired-in items the following day. Access to begin pack-up is from 08:00.

From six months *to the day.*

A gentle rhythm that gets you to the morning of your wedding without any last-minute scrambling.



SIX MONTHS OUT

Start collecting inspiration for ceremony & reception setup.

Book a viewing (or a second walk-through).

Confirm your main suppliers, planner, photographer, florist.



THREE MONTHS OUT

Finalise your décor ideas.

Send guests their accommodation and weekend details.

Consider a pre-wedding braai or guided walk with your people.



ONE MONTH OUT

Book your **food tasting** with our chef, this must be done at least one month before the wedding. Please note we don't host tastings on Saturdays.

Send us your final schedule, supplier list, and bar choices.

Confirm guest accommodation bookings.

Step outside and breathe. It's nearly here.

THREE WEEKS BEFORE, FOR OUR TEAM

- **Final schedule**, timings for ceremony, canapés, dinner, speeches, dancing. This lets us coordinate setup and assist your suppliers.
- **Supplier list**, names, services, arrival times and contact details. Let us know who you'd like us to greet directly.
- **Ceremony & reception layout**, preferred locations for the ceremony, bar, dance floor, gift table and welcome station. A simple sketch is plenty.
- **Bar arrangements**, final bar selection: open, cash, tab, or signature.
- **Guest list & accommodation**, confirmed bookings, with rooms allocated. Pre-wedding braai numbers if applicable.
- **Dance floor placement**, inside or on the stoep.
- **Personal touches**, surprises, rituals or traditions you'd like us to help with.

Final guest list and remaining balance: two weeks before the wedding.

The shape of *your wedding*.

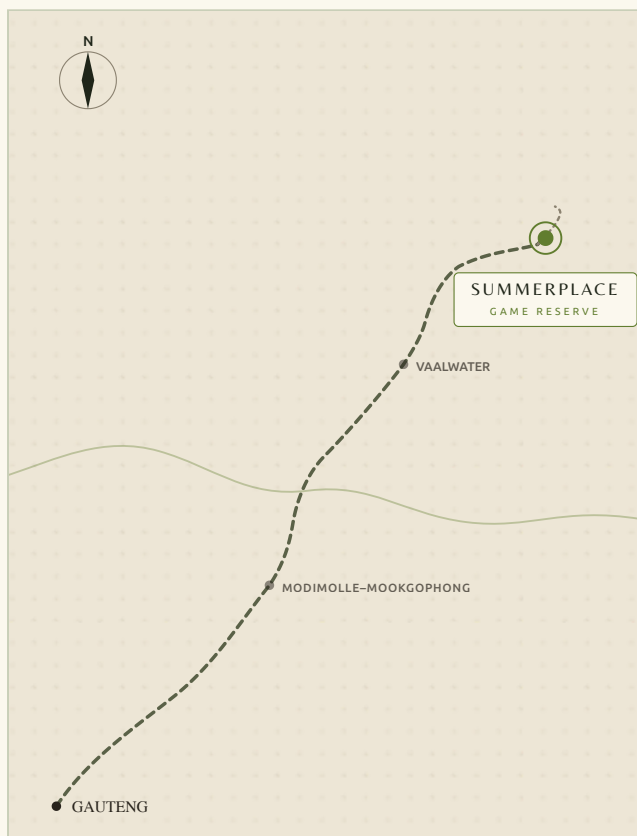
